The JC have kept costs down by using existing course maintenance staff and equipment but haven't invested much time into income generation. Thus it has been running at a small loss over the last few years.

It should also ensure improvement to course conditions and maintaining greater consistency. The bottom line is that any plan must produce a profit. The committee has trawled members about future commitment for membership with increased membership fees not least to cover the significant increased costs. However as a large proportion of income is generated from green fees we would like to get a feel from the occasional players about future interest and particularly green fees.
